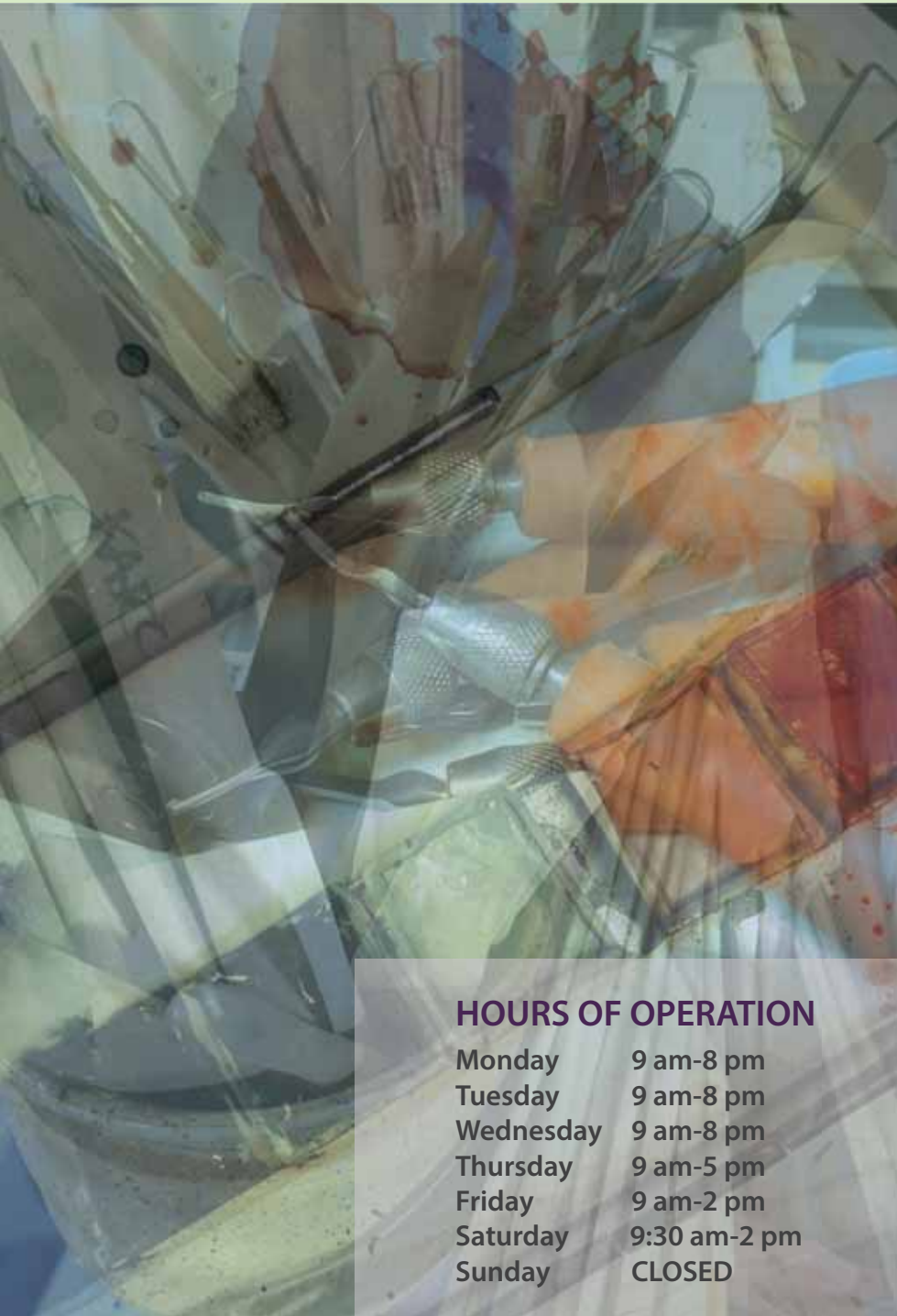

HOW TO REGISTER

You can register for classes online at knoxvilletn.gov/kafcc, by phone at (865)523-1401, or in person. Payment is due at the time of registration and no later than **five working days** of the class start date. Please note that no student's space will be held without full payment. Cash, checks, and credit cards are accepted. We cannot prorate sessions. We ask that you register for all long classes (4, 5, 6, or 8-weeks) at least 5 business days prior to the start of class. Please register for all 1 or 2-Day classes or workshops at least 2 business days prior to the start date of class. Online registration for classes will close once the registration deadline has past. All registrations and payments made past the registration deadline will be subject to a late fee.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

All classes must meet the minimum enrollment requirement. Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment one week prior to class start date will be cancelled. Fees are 100% refundable if the class is canceled by Knoxville Arts and Fine Crafts Center. Students needing to cancel, should notify KAFCC as soon as possible. Refunds and credits are given at the discretion of the City of Knoxville.

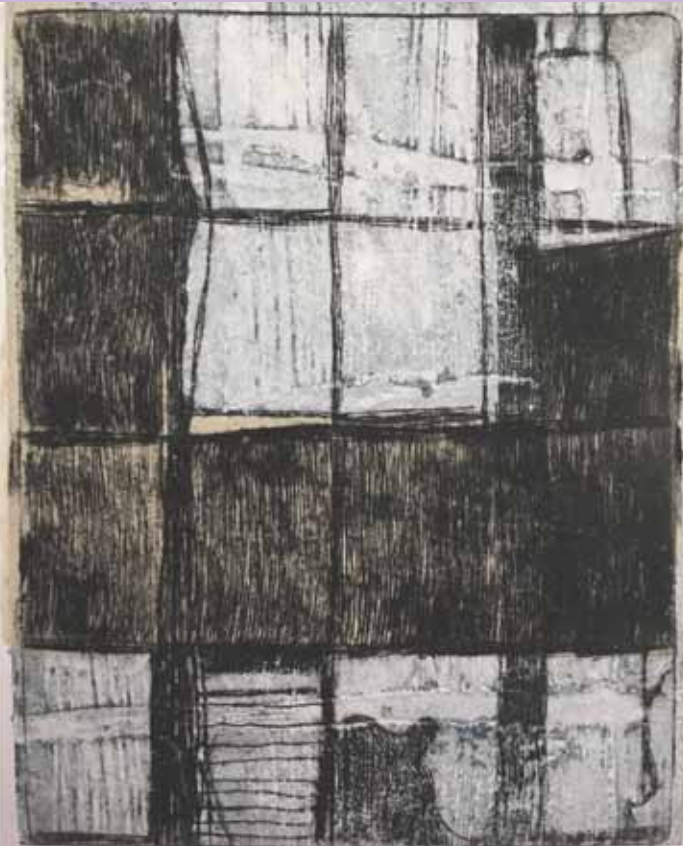
