




What school do you attend?

Have you ever participated in or attended any of the following? (may select more than one)




What prevents you from engaging with local government?

"I don't know enough about it"






Do you know where to seek help if you need it?




Do you know how to ask for help?




If you knew how and where, WOULD you seek help?



Does your school provide enough support for mental health?




Does your community outside of school provide enough support for mental health?






Have you ever been in the presence of violence?




Do you know someone affected by violence?




How easy is it for youth to access weapons?



How safe do you feel at school?




How safe do you feel in your neighborhood?






Is homelessness and lack of affordable housing a problem for youth in Knoxville?




Have you ever experienced homelessness?

Do you have friends who have experienced homelessness?











Have you ever been in the presence of violence?






Have you ever afraid of or close to experiencing homelessness?


What does a Knoxville look like where youth have easy access to mental health services?

Community Engagement

Objective - School-Based group of students that is in charge of finding civic engagement opportunities and distributing at their school

Goal - Youth Council Initiates Program

Action Step - Develop plan at next Youth Council Meeting

Objective - Create a bus route on election days that picks up eligible voters who have transportation barriers

Goal - Youth Council meet with KAT and learn about current plans and develop what the route could look like on election days

Objective - Have a better understanding of what local government is doing

Goal - City Council members and City leadership visiting schools and/or making video recaps that can be shared on social media and in schools (maybe government classes)

Action Step - Youth Council meet with Communications

Objective - Create sports and arts activities for youth from different schools to meet eachother

Goal - Knoxville Museum Art - Painting Activity Dodgeball or Kickball - UT Rec Sports

Action Step - Youth Council meet with Parks and Rec

Mental Health

Objective - Peer-led Support Group

Goal - Provide safe spaces to discuss mental health topics outside of schooltime. Adult sponsor/mentor to help provide support

Action Steps

Objective - Monthly/yearly training for school counselors

Goal - staying up to date on current issues teens are dealing with

Action Steps - Youth Council research what is already being done and set up opportunities to speak with anyone in charge of counselor training

Objective - Mental Health Community Engagement Event

Goal - Combine a fun event with mental health discussions

Action Steps - Youth Council start planning

Violence Prevention

Objective - Healthy programs and support groups

Goal - providing a safe haven environment, safer events

Action Steps - Youth Council work on planning

Objective - Classes for peaceful conflict resolution and parenting

Goal - Creating more nurturing environments, and knowing how to safely deal with conflict

Action Steps - Youth Council work on developing plan

Homelessness

Objective - Community Engagement Newsletter

Goal - Create network of different nonprofit organizations in a multimedia network to be more accessible - social media advertising and physical pamphlets.

Action Steps - Meet with nonprofit orgs to research their resources and gauge interest for being included

Objective - Nonprofit Fair

Goal - In-person resource fair for nonprofit organizations to advertise resources they offer.

Action Steps - Reach out to Homelessness Coalition and Homeless Youth Council to coordinate

Objective - ID Card Program

Goal - make sure youth have access to social services and employment by obtaining ID

Action Steps - Assess current programs and find gaps (funding, transportation, etc.)
