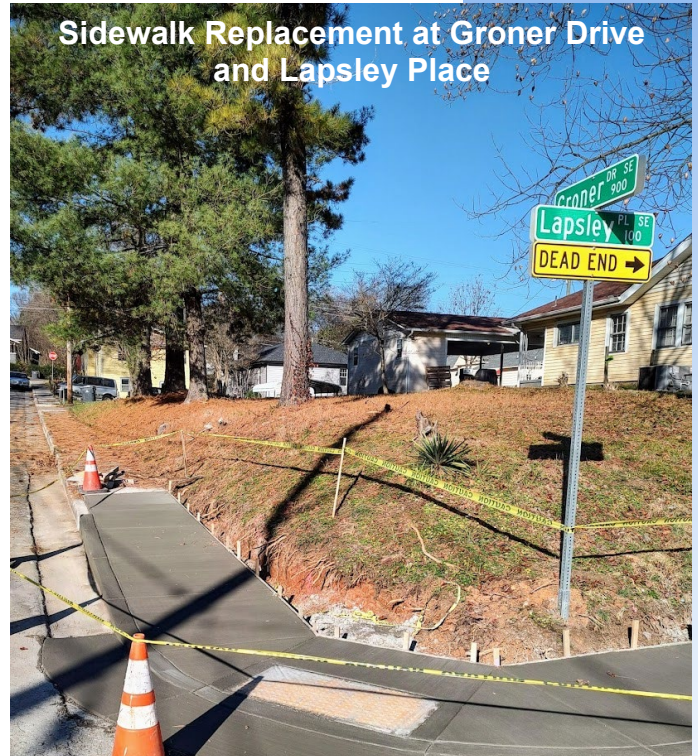




2020 On-Call Sidewalk Replacement Phase II Project

Project Description: The original Invitation to Bid for the 2020 On-Call Sidewalk Replacement Project contemplated one full year of on-call sidewalk replacement work throughout the City, with the option to enter into a second year of equivalent work under the same pricing. The pace and quality of the work to date support continued operations through the second year. This 2020 Sidewalk Replacement Project Phase II contract represents the second year of the project. This project will remove and replace 40,000 square feet of sidewalk at various sites throughout the City. Sites include:

- ADA Improvements at Fountain City Park & Lake;
- Anita Drive (2300 block - even side);
- Camp Avenue (900 block - even side);
- Clinch Avenue (1300 block - odd side);
- Davenport Road (3200 block - odd side);
- E Magnolia Avenue (2600 block - odd side);
- Fern Street (100 block - even side);
- Garden Drive (3400 block - even side);
- Knoxville College Dr (800 block - even side);
- Manderly Way (7300 block - both sides);
- Moses Avenue (1400 block - odd side);
- N Central Street (2700 block - even side);
- Ogden Street (300 block - odd side);
- Oglewood Avenue (1000 block – odd side);
- Parkside Drive (11200 block - odd side);
- Portion of Fort Kid Site and Sidewalk Renovations
- Raleigh Avenue (900 block - even side);
- Ray Mears Blvd (8000 block - odd side);
- Sheridan Street (2400 block - odd side);
- Sherrod Road (2700 block - even side);
- Spence Place (2100 block - odd side);
- Terrace Avenue (2000 block - odd side);
- W Depot Ave (200 block - odd side);
- Washington Pike (2600 block - even side);
