Tie Games	In Regular Season play there will be 1 Inning of International Tiebreaker, where the last player to have completed an official at bat begins on second base. If there is no winner the game shall end in a tie. In City Tournament, the International Tiebreaker Rule is used in all extra innings until a winner is determined.						

^{*}All players on roster must play at least 1 inning. This includes offense and defense. Substitution rules to accomplish the playing time rule will be as follows:

- A. Any player may be substituted for or replaced and re-entered once, provided the players occupy their same batting position in the batting order.
- B. The starting player and their substitute may not be in the line-up at the same time.
- C. If a player re-enters the game a second time or a player re-enters the game in a position in the batting order other than their original starting or substitute position, this is considered an illegal re-entry.
