YES

✓ METALS

Aluminum cans, steel cans, tin cans, & lids



✓ PLASTICS

#1 and #2 containers including cups, bottles, jugs, & secured caps



✓ PAPER

Cartons, cups, plates, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, books, shredded paper secured in paper bags, mixed paper, & envelopes



✓ CARDBOARD

Shipping & toilet paper/paper towel tubes as well as flattened boxes including pizza, takeout, snack, & cereal boxes.



✗ Plastic bags or flexible plastic film of any thickness



✗ Paper towels, napkins, or tissues



✗ Coffee/tea/creamer pods



✗ Pet food bags, chip bags, or snack wrappers



✗ Straws, stirrers, styrofoam, or plastic utensils



✗ Aluminum foil or disposable baking pans



✗ Food or dirty food wrappers



✗ Ink cartridges, batteries, light bulbs, or electronics



✗ Tanglers: hoses, cords, string lights, etc.



NOTE:
All recyclable containers must be rinsed out and free of any food.
