Any non-profit organization may apply for a grant if it operates within the City of Knoxville <u>has been in operation for at least two years</u> and is registered as a charitable organization with the Tennessee Secretary of State or has a current exemption.

The FY 2024-2025 Opioid Abatement Grant applications are on the city's website at www.KnoxvilleTN.gov/CityGrants. Funding will be distributed quarterly during the 2024-25 fiscal year. Applicants should follow all instructions, provide attachments as instructed and make use of the check list. Please limit your responses to the space provided on the application form.

Applications that detail the organization's efforts to mitigate and prevent Opioid addiction in the City of Knoxville will be given priority. We will also consider applications in the context of other funds granted to an agency as we strive to meet as many requests as possible within budget constraints.

The <u>signed applications must be received by Thursday, February 15, 2024 by 4pm</u>. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
