Project Description: In 2015 the City of Knoxville completed the \$1.4 million Fort Dickerson Roadway Realignment Project that included the addition of a much-needed traffic signal for the park’s main entrance off of Chapman Highway. Fort Dickerson Road was realigned with Woodlawn Pike and now includes approximately a new two-lane road complete with sidewalk access. City officials are now preparing to move forward with construction of the park’s entrance improvements, which include landscaping, signage, a new transit stop and a decorative veneer for the 30-foot-high retaining wall. In 2015, the Aslan Foundation acquired adjacent property and then donated this property to the City to be used as part of the landscaping improvement project.
